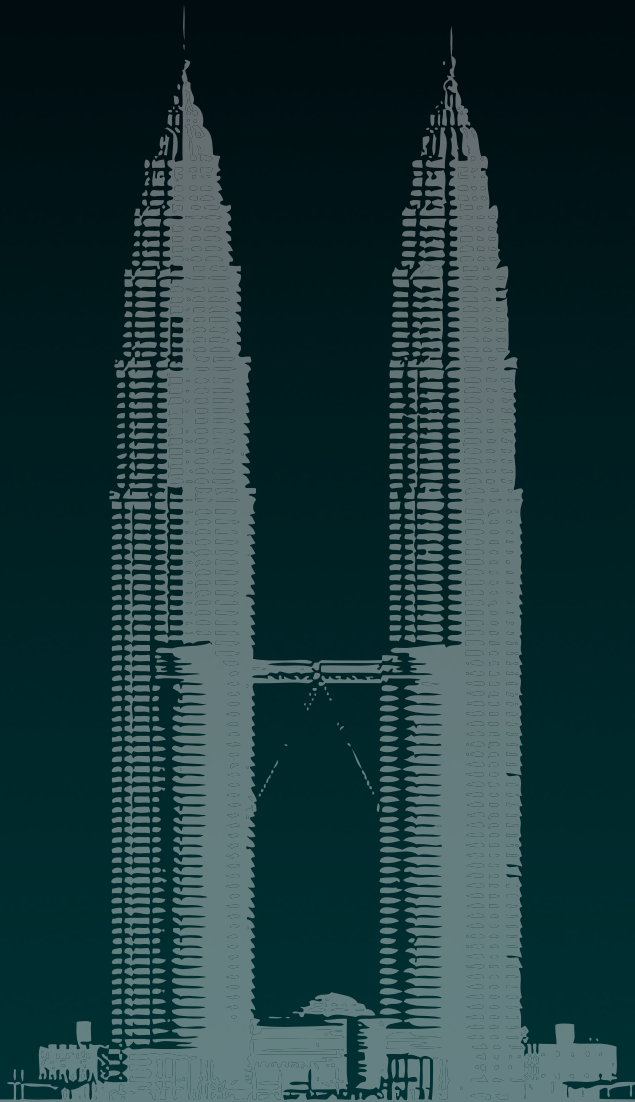

- ▶ Dissertation

Assessment

Each module consists of scheduled classes, guided learning and self-directed learning. Assessment is via a combination of group seminars, assignments, presentations and the major project.
